How to get Transcripts

- The easiest way to request a transcript is to email our assistant Tracy Coates at tracycoates@hjisd.net.
- You can also request transcripts in the Counselors' Office. Fill out the form & place it in the basket on the black bookshelf.
- Each paper transcript cost \$2. You **<u>MUST</u>** pay for these **<u>BEFORE</u>** you order them.
- Electronic transcripts are free. We can send electronic transcripts to MOST colleges in Texas.
- Mrs. Coates, our assistant, handles all transcript requests.
- Students can pick them up approx. 24 hours after requesting them.

Texas Success Initiative Assessment 2 (TSIA 2)

The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board rules require that all students in Texas public colleges and universities complete the TSI Assessment 2 (TSIA 2). The purpose is to determine a student's degree of college readiness.

Who must complete the TSIA 2?

All students seeking an Associate's Degree or a certificate program that is 43 semester credit hours or more are required to take the TSI Assessment 2, unless they meet exemptions. Certificate programs with less than 43 semester credit hours that require math and/or writing will require a student to take certain parts of the TSIA 2 as a prerequisite, unless exemptions are met. Students must complete the TSIA 2 Pre-Assessment Activity before taking the TSIA 2.

How do I register for the TSI Assessment 2 with LIT?

- Contact the Testing Center at 409-241-9701 or 409-247-4978
- On or prior to test day (except Saturdays), obtain a Testing Form (neon pink) at the Cashier's Office, located in the Cecil Beeson Building. Complete required information, pay at the Cashiers and proceed to Testing Center in the Eagles' Nest Building room 115 with receipt and Testing Form to schedule or take exam.
- If you are unable to come in to pay and if you have access to a fax machine and a credit/debit card, you may contact the cashiers at 409-839-2071 or 409-839-2049. They will send you a credit card authorization form and a test form to complete to return by fax. Once they process they payment, they will send you a receipt. We request that you forward the emailed receipt and the testing form to testingcenter@lit.edu with your request to test. You may request a particular time and date and we will respond back with an answer.
- You may come in as a walk in, but no seat is guaranteed. especially during peak testing times, such as class registration periods in November-January and April-August.
- Saturday testing is available with an appointment and pre-payment. No walk-ins for Saturday testing. Please contact the Testing Center for Saturday dates.
